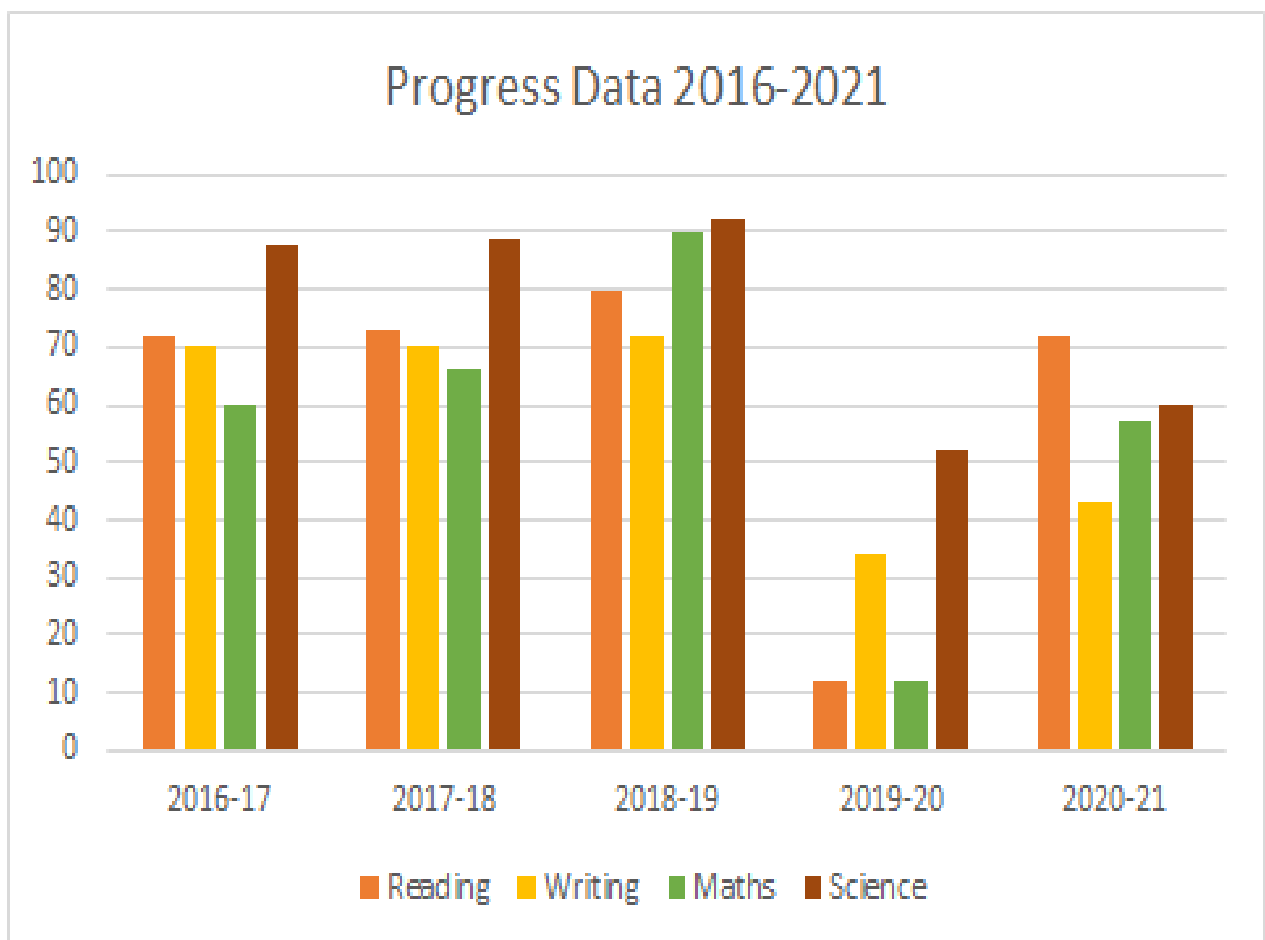


End of Year Data Analysis 2020-21

The last 18 months has seen an unprecedented effect on education with the arrival of Covid 19 in the Spring Term 2019. Initially education immediately transferred to online learning however, this was not without difficulty. Many students had difficulty accessing appropriate online learning and education packs were sent home. Some students refused to engage initially whilst others struggled without staff support.

On returning to the classroom in 2020 a recovery curriculum was implemented to promote social, emotional and mental health whilst delivering a curriculum to refocus academic learning. This again was interrupted by a surge in Covid 19 cases in January 2021 and education moved to online learning integrated with student 'bubbles'. The data herein demonstrates the profound effect that Covid had on the education of some of our students over this period of time. Nevertheless, we are extremely proud to report the successes of our students who were entered for examinations and qualifications.
